Round one is the first chance to show that last season wasn't a one-off and that they're ready to go again.

Across both sides, the message is pretty simple; work hard, play your role, and build from the start. Whether it's a fresh group finding its feet or a premiership team defending its crown, round one is all about laying the foundation for the season ahead.
